We're really sorry to tell you that our branch at 157 Bramcote Lane, Wollaton will be closing on 21/12/2022.

Here we'll explain more about why we've made the decision to close this branch and tell you about the services and support that will be available to you after this branch has closed.

The way members use this branch is changing


Before we make the decision to close any branch, we think carefully about how it is being used. We consider how many customers are visiting, what kind of transactions are being made, and all the other ways members have been choosing to save with us. We also take into consideration the availability of other branches in the wider community.

Here are the main reasons why the branch is closing:

- The number of counter transactions has reduced by 39% in the last 12 months
- In the past 12 months, 57% of customers who made a transaction have also used a different branch
- The branch team carry out an average of just 32 transactions per day
