

## 1. How to control and delete cookies

The Nottingham will not use cookies to collect personally identifiable information about you. However, if you wish to restrict or block the cookies which are set by The Nottingham's websites, or indeed any other website, you can do this through your browser settings. The Help function within your browser should tell you how.

Alternatively, you may wish to visit <http://www.aboutcookies.org> which contains comprehensive information on how to do this on a wide variety of browsers. You will also find details on how to delete cookies from your computer as well as more general information about cookies. For information on how to do this on the browser of your mobile phone you will need to refer to your handset manual.

Please be aware that restricting cookies may impact on the functionality of The Nottingham's websites.

## 2. List of the main cookies used on The Nottingham's websites

This is a list of the main cookies set by The Nottingham's websites, and what each is used for.

Cookie name	Purpose
eSavings session cookie (JSESSIONID)	For security checks in eSavings website – removed at Log-off
eSavings ticket cookie (Dynamically named)	For security checks in eSavings – removed at Log-off
MSP session cookie (Dynamically named)	For security checks in Intermediary Online Trading Service website(MSP) –deleted when user closes browser
Session cookie (ASP.NET_SessionId)	For security checks on Recruitment website – deleted when user closes browser
Content Management System cookies (EkAnalytics, EktGUID)	Set by our content management system on some browsers. Not used for any Society purpose – deleted when user closes browser.
cookieMSGCheck	Used when you accept cookies from <a href="http://www.thenottingham.com">www.thenottingham.com</a> site (will expire after 30 days if no further visit)
mortFinder_purpose mortFinder_mtype mortFinder_valueOfProperty mortFinder_loanRequired	Used with the "Find the right mortgage" application. Stores generic information for calculating mortgage used. Deleted when user closes browser.
